### REPORT FOR THE YEAR 1886.

My dear friends,

I have much pleasure in presenting the usual annual Statement of the sums received from collections in the Mission Chapels at Singapore and Jurong, and other sources; and of the manner in which money so obtained has been expended.

It is gratifying to record that the two collections at Advent and Whit-Sunday towards the support of the local Mission amounted to a larger sum than in past years,—\$150.30, which was paid to St. V. B. Down, Esq., Honorary Treasurer of the St. Andrew's Church Mission Committee.

Two handsome silver Alms-dishes have been presented as a thank-offering by a member of the Tamil congregation, which, I take this opportunity, of publicly acknowledging.

A sum of £10 equal to \$61.54 has been given by the Revd. W. Forbes Capel, with the request that it should be expended on the Mission Chapel, when the new School is built and the Chapel is used exclusively for the performance of divine service.

In conclusion, I have to express my

grateful sense of the liberal support given in money and labour by the congregation. "God is not unrighteous to forget your work, and labour of love, which ye have shewed towards His name in that ye have ministered to the saints and do minister." Heb: vi. 10.
